Literacy

Continue to read our individual Reading Books/key words and Harder to Read and Spell words, Phase 3 Phonics –ELS Scheme and practise daily at home. Continue to listen to lots of stories and rhymes. To begin to learn Phase 3 Phonic sounds.-read simple words ,captions and sentences-ELS Scheme 'Draw and Write Club' –we will learn a story, animation or Traditional tale, draw and write about our own innovations of them using our phonic knowledge to write ourselves!

To continue to write our own name and other things such as labels and captions, by listening to sounds in words and being a 'brave' writer to write it for ourselves.

Communication and Language – We will;
