## Literacy

- We will read a variety of Traditional Tales
- We will write stories with a beginning, middle and end based on traditional tales
- We will use openings and closings in our work 'one sunny day.....'
- We will begin to use 'and' as a joining word in our writing
- We will use the story of 'The Little Red Hen' as a basis for our own story, changing characters and key events

## Science

- We will look at different types of weather
- We will keep a weather diary– seasonal changes
- We will investigate water—freezing and melting
- We will learn about The Water Cycle
- We will learn about the force of the wind
- We will investigate waterproof materials

## PE

Games we will play simple team games developing spatial awareness and movement

Gymnastics following the NT Scheme we will develop travelling skills and holding weight on different points

- I think before I make choices




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## Geography/History Being a Geographer

## Computing

- We will explore digital sound
- We will experiment with beats, tempo and composition
- We will explore a variety of tools and resources

## At Home

Look at the weather map during the weather forecast and look at where we live we will explore digital sound  
Find the different parts of the UK on the map  
Look at the weather each day and talk about how it changes  
Read some traditional stories at home and talk about their openings and closings

## Numeracy

- We will look at and explore number bonds within 10
- We will explore addition within 10 using problems and number stories
- We will explore subtraction within 10 using number stories and word problems
- We will begin to investigate place value and numbers to 20

## RE

- We will learn about 'Belonging' and how through Baptism we are welcomed into God's family
- We will learn about Advent, the time of waiting

## Art, Design and Technology

Constructing a windmill—DT

- Identify some features that would appeal to the client (The Little Red Hen) and create a suitable design.
- Explain how their design appeals to the hen.
- Make stable structures, which will eventually support the turbine, out of card, tape and glue.
- Make functioning turbines and axles that are assembled into the main supporting structure.
- Say what is good about their windmill and what they could do better.

## Music

- Rhythm In The Way We Walk (Reggae style) and Banana Rap (Hip Hop style). You will Listen & Appraise other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games and singing.
