

# Year 5 – Summer 2

## Literacy

This half term we will be basing our work on our class reading for pleasure novel, *The Explorer*, and writing our own adventure narratives. Within this unit, we will look at letter writing in style of the character and finish with non-chronological reports.



## Numeracy

This half term we will look at negative numbers, converting units and volume. We will complete our summer NFER assessment.

The children will continue to practise times tables to ensure they can easily retrieve knowledge.



## Geography

This half term the children will be learning about the coast. They will learn about famous coastlines, erosion and the disappearing coastline. We are very fortunate to live where we do and so we will carry out fieldwork at the coast for our final two lessons as part of this unit!

## RE

We will follow the 'Come and See' scheme of work. We will look at:

Freedom and Responsibility: Commandments enable Christians to be free and responsible.  
Stewardship: The Church is called to the stewardship of creation.

## Science

This half term we will focus on living things and their habitats and animals including humans. The children will learn about mammalian, amphibian, insect and bird life cycles, before looking at reproduction in plants and reproduction in animals.



## PE

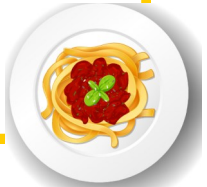
Mr Tony will continue to work with our class weekly this half term focussing on athletics, just in time for sports day! Our other unit of work will be dodgeball. We will look at attacking, defending, blocking and power.

## Computing

This term we will introduce children to programming LEGO Robots. They will control their movement with precise calculations and coding, then utilise the robot's sensors to interact with its environment and solve problems.

## Art, Design and Technology

This half term we will be returning to our design technology curriculum and we will be looking at food technology! The children will learn a Bolognese recipe and adapt it to improve nutritional content. They will practise food preparation skills, design a product label and create their finished recipe.



## PSHE

Children will follow the weekly statements to live by. We will continue our PSHE scheme using TenTen. This half term will focus on: the Holy Trinity, Catholic Social Teaching, reaching out, the world of work and money.

## French

Our final unit is My French Family. We will look at how to say which siblings we have, name different members of our family tree, describe my family and their likes and dislikes and express and understand simple opinions.



## Music

This half term the children will be continuing their work on Charanga, consolidating all of our learning for this year.
